

After-school Program Carbon Corps Mentor

United Way of the Greater Lehigh Valley (UWGLV) seeks an enthusiastic, independent, and professional community-based Mentor for an exciting, new **AmeriCorps** program. An AmeriCorps assignment is a service position that is grant funded and lasts for one year.

The members are placed in schools or after school programs throughout the Carbon County, Pa region.

Our main program goals revolve around education and mentoring. Members will be placed directly in an after-school support program where they work with a group of students – giving them additional support. They may also work one on one or in small groups throughout the day.

- Mentor utilizing an evidence-based curriculum to create and lead SEL (Social Emotional Learning) sessions with students 1-to-1 in grades K-6.
- Communicate regularly with parents regarding attendance, progress reports, and inform them of other community resources available.
- Students may be supported in person or via virtual mediums.

The service term is November 2020-July 2021. (450 hours total / 10-12 hrs per week)

2 positions available – Monday thru Thursday 3:30pm-6:30pm OR Friday 8am-4pm and one 3:30pm-6:30pm shift.

AmeriCorps members earn a living stipend (\$3800 total) and at upon successful completion of their service hours, they are eligible for an education award (\$1638.89) that can be applied towards student loans or future educational expenses.
