ACHIEVED ATTENDANCE GOALS

Central Elementary School set a goal to improve student attendance by 5% and surpassed it with an 8% increase in 2021-22. The Community School Coordinator focused on family engagement and communication via phone and a virtual app to promote awareness for events, activities and important dates, as well as implemented a class rewards system recognizing those with good attendance. In addition, the Community School Coordinator identified chronic absentee students and enrolled them in after-school programs to encourage everyday attendance.
