MARVINE FAMILY AND COMMUNITY CENTER OPENS

Marvine celebrated the official ribbon cutting for The Marvine Family and Community Center, which is the center of their Community School work and the home of their food pantry, clothing closet and Community School Coordinator office. It also houses the PAT program, Pre-K Counts office and working stations with computers available for families.
