ACHIEVED ATTENDANCE GOALS

Sheridan Elementary strived to reach pre-pandemic attendance rates in the 2021-22 school year. Sheridan finished the year with 86.2% of students regularly attending school. Thanks to the leadership of Iron Falcon Academy, students were able to learn Taekwondo and to lead by example inside and outside their community. Sheridan offered this opportunity to students with attendance problems and saw an improvement as they now come to school motivated and on time. Parents have also found it beneficial as it aims to support working families. The Community School Coordinator sees family engagement and building trust with families as one of the strongest approaches to reengaging students and families with the school. While they are still building these bridges, 500 of the 660 families attended parent teacher conferences this past year.

ACHIEVED FAMILY ENGAGEMENT GOALS

One of the most successful strategies implemented through the support plan was increased access to extracurricular activities for Sheridan families. Sheridan successfully ended the 2021-22 school year with several new after-school programs, enrolling 102 students. Students were exposed to extracurricular activities including karate, skateboarding, pickleball, lego engineering club, Da Vinci Science Center and Baum School of Art.
