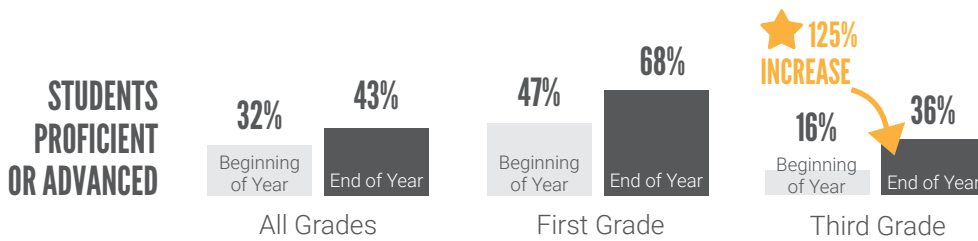

ACADEMIC GROWTH ACROSS EVERY GRADE LEVEL

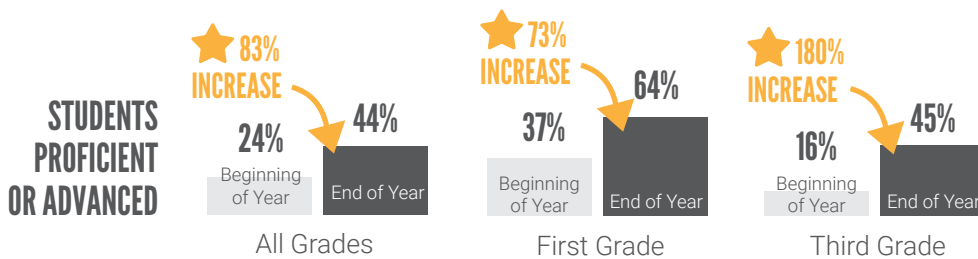

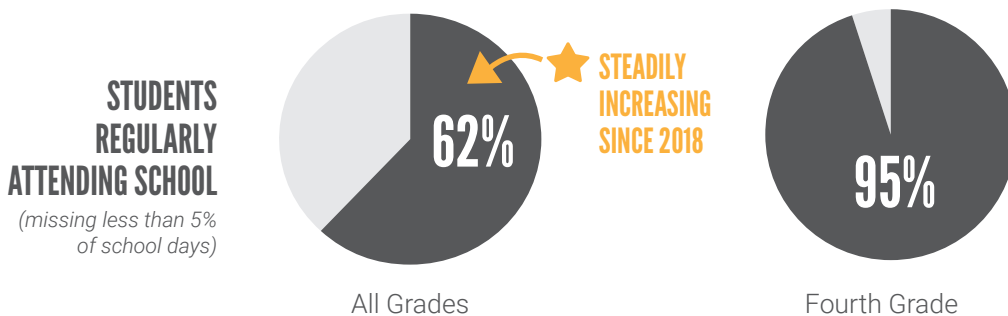

IMPROVED EVERYDAY ATTENDANCE RATE

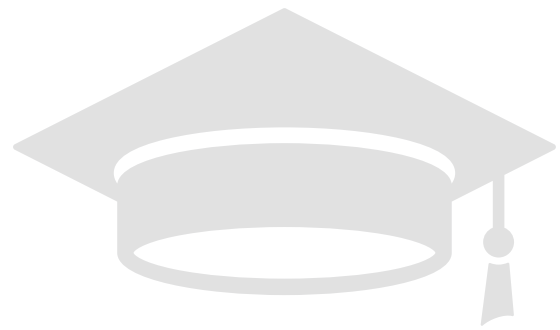

STUDENT MENTAL HEALTH

CONTINUED TO INCREASE CONNECTIONS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

100% of students referred for **behavioral health services** through the Student Assistance Program were connected to support
★ UP FROM 75.6% IN 2018-19



STUDENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

INCREASED PARTICIPATION IN AFTER-SCHOOL ENRICHMENT AND FAMILY EVENTS

- **160** students engaged in after-school learning
- **376** families attended **school events**
★ **BEST PARTICIPATION SINCE 2017**
- **231**, or 40%, of parents or caregivers participated in **parent-teacher conferences**
★ **169% INCREASE SINCE 2018-19**

New monthly parent meetings strengthened school-family partnerships and helped Cheston understand what families most needed. More than 50 unduplicated parents attended each month throughout the entire school year.



FAMILY STABILITY

INCREASED CONNECTIONS TO FOOD, HOUSING AND FINANCIAL SUPPORTS

- **224** students connected with **dental and vision services**
★ **THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF STUDENTS SINCE 2017**
- **93%** of families who requested support had at least three of their prioritized **basic needs met**
- Provided larger families with double the usual amount of **food** to ensure that everyone had enough

"This represents a significant increase and accomplishment in addressing family basic needs at a time when basic needs requests are increasing."

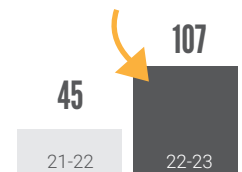
