

# **FAMILY STABILITY**

#### STRENGTHENED WITH FEWER REFERRALS

Fewer referrals to food, housing and financial supports, in combination with decreased chronic absenteeism, suggest that Roosevelt families may be experiencing greater financial stability.



In 2022-23, Roosevelt had an on-site food bank for students, run by the Community School Coordinator. Teachers referred students and at the end of the day, students stopped by the food bank for a bag of food to take home with them. A partnership with Nativity Church helped to provide additional meal kits for families.
