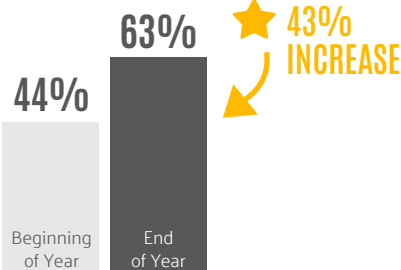

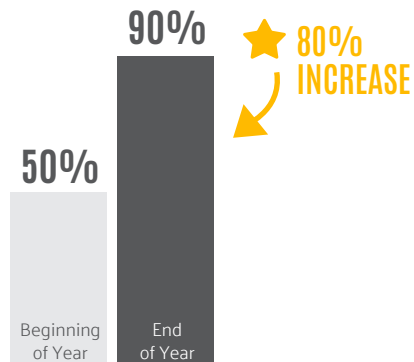

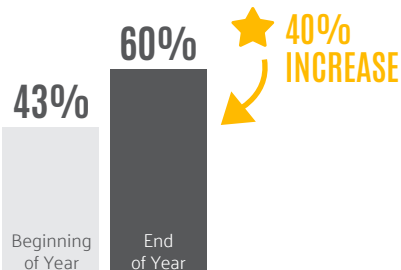

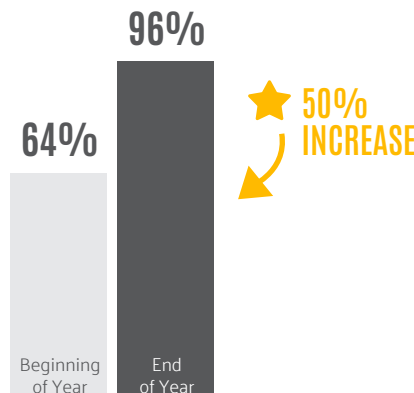

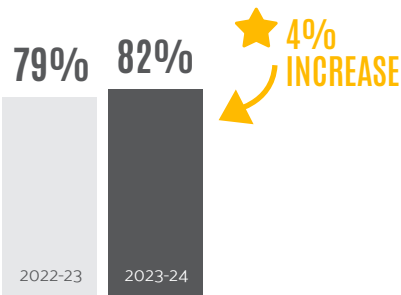


## STUDENT ATTENDANCE

93% (beginning of year) → 97.25% (end of year)



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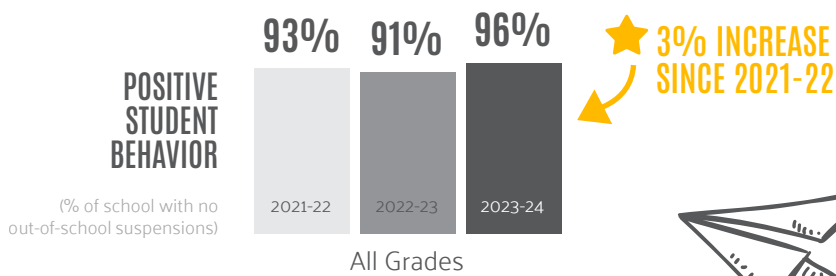
## STUDENT MENTAL HEALTH

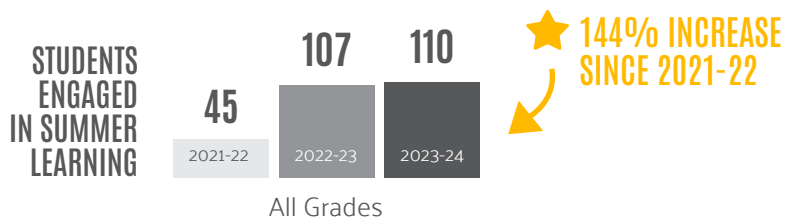
With Social-Emotional Learning a top priority at Cheston, staff utilized **calming corners** to allow students to regulate their emotions, reset and return to class without needing a formal referral, significantly reducing the time students spent out of the classroom.

**Sensory Workshops** provided creative and calming after-school activities for students to create self-regulating tools such as calming beads, infinity cubes and stress balls. This hands-on approach helped students understand how tools can support emotional regulation and focus and were some of the most popular and well-attended student engagement opportunities in 2023-24.

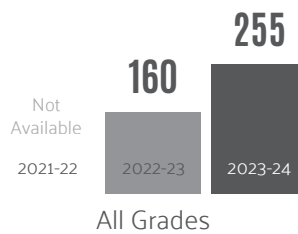

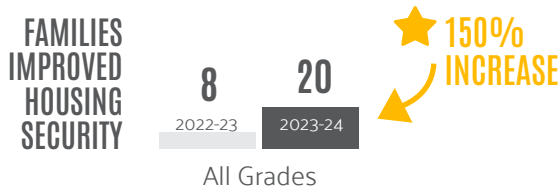
## FAMILY STABILITY

**20 FAMILIES** improved housing security through housing and financial services offered by Family Connection of Easton.

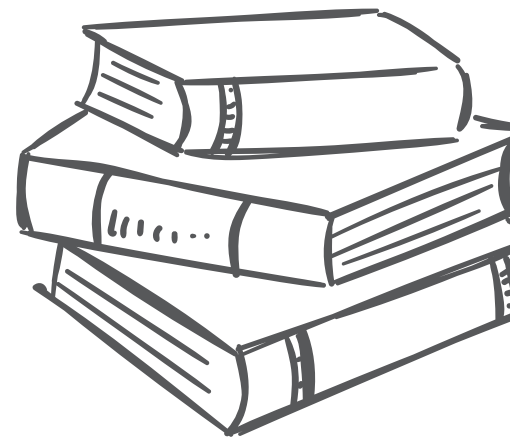
